Chad Spencer

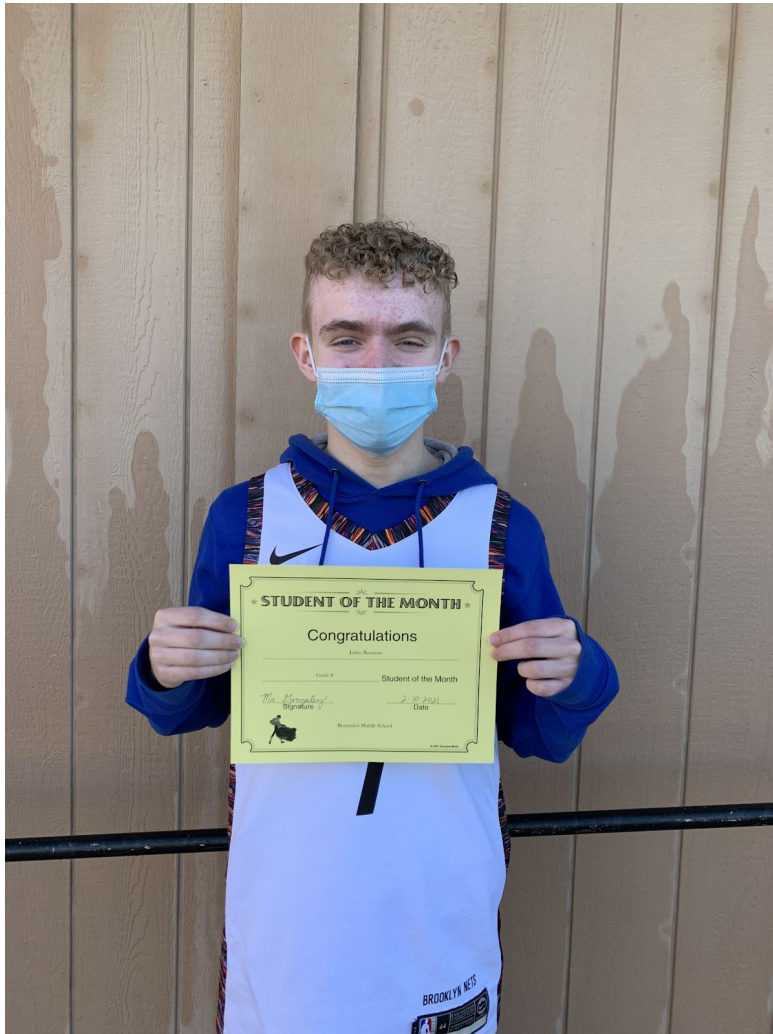
